**DECISION № 759 - PD**

**from 9.9.2009**

An application № RG-05-1499/1 from 03.07.2009 for confirmation by the Financial Supervision Commission (FSC) of the prospectus and the supplementary prospectus letters № RG-05-1499/1 from 18.08.2009 and № RG-05-1499/1 from 26.08.2009, corrected prospectuses for admission to trading on a regulated market of shares issued by Bougatsa.Com AD, Sofia and attached documents.

Taking into account that the submitted application and accompanying documents meet the requirements of the Public Offering of Securities Act (POSA) and the Decree № 2 to prospectuses for public offering and admission to trading on a regulated securities market and disclosure of information by public companies and other issuers of securities (Decree № 2) and Regulation № 22 on the terms and conditions for entry and exit of public companies and other issuers of securities and securities issues in register of the Financial Supervision Commission (Ordinance № 22), pursuant to Art. 13, para. 1, item 8 of the Financial Supervision Commission (Financial Supervision Commission Act) Art. 91 POSA, art. 15 para. 2 of Decree № 2, Art. 10, para. 2 and art. 12, para. 1 of Regulation № 22

**Financial Supervision Commission**

**DECIDED:**

**Confirms the prospectus for admission to trading on a regulated market of issue of shares issued by Bougatsa.Com AD amounting to BGN 100 000, divided into 100,000 ordinary, registered, dematerialized, free to trade share, with 1 voting right each and nominal value of BGN 1 each, with ISIN code BG1100022091, representing the legal registered capital of the company.**

**Enter that issue of shares in the register under Art. 30, para. 1, item 3 of the Financial Supervision Commission Act, led by FSC to trading on a regulated market.**

**Enter Bougatsa.Com AD, as a public company in the register under Art. 30, para. 1, item 3 of the Financial Supervision Commission Act, led by FSC.**

The decision is subject to appeal in the Supreme Administrative Court of Bulgaria in the 14 - day period after its announcement. Appeals against the decision will not stop the execution of the individual administrative act.
